## A HUMBLE REQUEST

*Kindly extend your cooperation regarding the following issues :*

- Please refrain from entering the Club in **Chappals/Shorts/ Bermudas**.
- Please don't smoke in non-smoking areas.
- The **members should strictly accompany their guests**. - Members who intend to bring more than 15 guests on a particular day are required to book some part of the Club premises to entertain their group. Similarly, members who intend to bring more than 10 (but less than 15) guests on a particular day are required to inform the Manager of the Club at least 24 hours in advance to get prior permission from the Management, so that adequate arrangements are made and they can enjoy their visit.
