From The *President's Desk*



Respected Members,

There has been much discussion regarding the current state of our swimming pool and its transition into an all-weather facility. We understand that despite recent upgrades, the "chill factor" during peak winter remains a significant barrier to your enjoyment.

To provide historical context: the original Master Plan approved by the General House envisioned a standard seasonal pool. Consequently, the initial infrastructure did not include provisions for climate control. In January' 2025, in an effort to enhance member facilities, the Management Committee initiated a conversion by installing high-efficiency heat pumps and a fiber-sheet roofing system.

While these additions have successfully warmed the water, we recognize a critical remaining challenge: the "wind tunnel" effect. The heritage cemented jalis, while architecturally beautiful, allow chilly winds to sweep across the deck. This creates a sharp temperature drop for swimmers exiting the water, posing a risk of discomfort and health concerns.

Simply "patching" the walls is not enough. To ensure a truly seamless winter swimming experience, the Management Committee, along with appointed architects and technical experts, is currently evaluating advanced solutions such as retractable walls and automated curtains. Our goal is to design a solution that:

- Neutralizes drafts without compromising the Heritage aesthetics of the jali work.
- Maintains ambient air temperature on the pool deck.
- Provides a "fail-safe" environment for our members' health.

Achieving a "perfect" all-weather environment in a structure not originally designed for it requires precision and patience. We are committed to presenting economically viable and foolproof engineering ideas shortly. We request your continued support as we finalize these plans to enhance our club's infrastructure.

As we head into the month of love, I hope you find plenty of moments to enjoy with your loved ones. Here's to brighter days, lighter hearts, and the promise of warmer weather just around the corner.

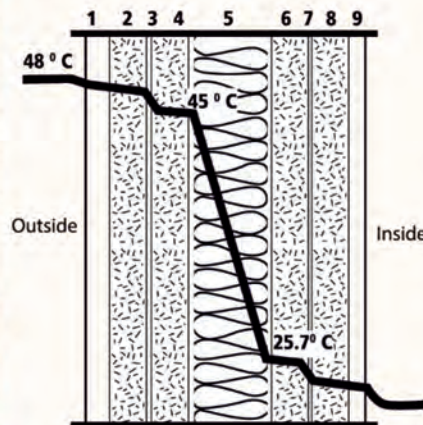
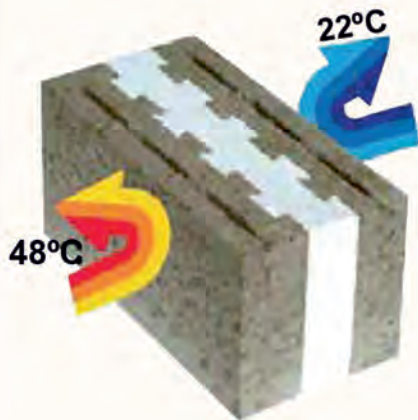

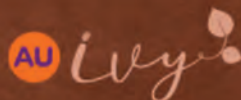
