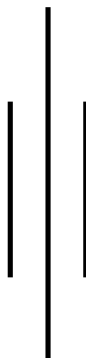

SECRETARY'S REPORT FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2025-26

On behalf of the Management Committee of Jaipur Club Ltd., I welcome you all to the 135th Annual General Meeting of our Club. The first financial year of the current Management Committee has now come to an end, so I'd like to take this opportunity to thank you all for the kind appreciation, support and faith you've shown towards us.

Managing the affairs of the Club would not have been possible without the unwavering support of my colleagues of the Management Committee, and I am extremely grateful to each one of them.

I would especially like to place on record my heartfelt gratitude to our esteemed **President, Er. Ajeet Saxena**, whose visionary leadership, vast experience and unwavering commitment played a pivotal role in the progress of the Club. His guidance and constant encouragement inspired the entire Management Committee and enabled us to address various challenges effectively while undertaking several developmental initiatives throughout the year.

Vice President CA Dinesh Goyal's timely advice proved extremely helpful in addressing various administrative and operational matters.

Joint Secretary (Admin), Shri P.K. Sooji, made a valuable contribution towards the smooth functioning of the Club's administrative affairs, while **Joint Secretary (Sports), Shri Mohan Lal Sardana**, worked enthusiastically towards the development and effective management of the Club's sports activities.

I would also like to convey my special appreciation to **Ex-Officio and Past Secretary, Shri Vishal Kaushal**, whose experience, guidance and continued support proved valuable to the Management Committee throughout the year.

All members of the Management Committee worked with sincerity and dedication to do justice to the portfolios entrusted to them. I extend my heartfelt thanks to each one of them for their cooperation and commitment.

FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE & OPERATIONAL REVIEW

The financial year 2025-26 has been a period of strict fiscal discipline, consolidation, and targeted growth.

Through strategic cost-management and revenue optimization, your club has maintained steady economic health.

The Club recorded a Cash Profit of ₹63.44 Lakhs before depreciation during the financial year, reflecting its sound financial management and operational efficiency.

Fixed Annual Overhead: Our foundational operational cost to keep the club functioning optimally stands at ₹6,15,00,000 (₹6.15 Crore). This encompasses statutory employee salaries, employee bonuses, uniforms, electricity tariffs, insurance policies, Annual Maintenance Contracts (AMCs), and mandatory land license fees paid to the Nagar Nigam and Railways.

Daily Sustainability Threshold: To break even on daily operations-excluding the cost of kitchen raw materials, liquor inventory, capital project expenses, and major entertainment events-the club required a baseline revenue generation of ₹1,69,000 per day. I am pleased to report that through your continuous patronage of the Club; we consistently met and exceeded this target.

In this context, I wish to express my sincere appreciation to members who have been prompt in clearing their dues. When the current Management Committee assumed office on 28th July, 2025, the members' outstanding dues amounted to Rs. 65,02,059/-. Understanding the gravity of the situation, we worked hard over the past few months and, through persistent communication, reminders, and dialogue, the outstanding amount is reduced to **Rs. 36,71,234/- Lakhs** as of 31st March, 2026.

On behalf of the Managing Committee, I would like to express my sincere appreciation to our **Treasurer CA Sanjay Pabuwal** for the meticulous preparation and presentation of the financial report. His dedication, transparency, and prudent financial management have ensured that the Club's accounts are maintained with the highest standards of accuracy and accountability.

We are grateful for his tireless efforts, sound financial guidance, and unwavering commitment to the Club's welfare. His contribution has played a significant role in maintaining the Club's financial strength and supporting its continued growth.



INFRASTRUCTURE & AMENITIES DEVELOPMENT

Enhancing the member experience through infrastructural upgrades remained at the forefront of our agenda throughout the year. Significant capital investments were made to create modern, functional, and aesthetically appealing facilities for our members.

The Bamboo Nook: We successfully inaugurated this premium, eco-friendly lounge space, which has quickly become a preferred venue for members to enjoy casual gatherings and relaxed evenings.

Zaika - Multi-Cuisine Restaurant: The Club proudly unveiled the **newly renovated and elegantly designed Zaika Multi-Cuisine Restaurant**, featuring contemporary interiors, enhanced ambience, and upgraded dining facilities. The formal inauguration of the restaurant marked a significant milestone in the Club's hospitality journey. With its refreshed décor, improved seating, and expanded culinary offerings, Zaika has elevated the overall dining experience and has become a preferred destination for members and their guests.

I am also pleased to report that the construction and interior fit-outs of our **brand-new Card Room, state-of-the-art Billiard Room, and newly developed Padel Ball** has been successfully completed and Pickle Ball courts will soon be completed and operation adding world-class recreational sporting facilities to the Club. These developments are expected to further enrich the member experience while enhancing the Club's long-term value and revenue potential.

I take this opportunity to place on record my sincere gratitude to our **Past Honorary Secretary Shri Dharmendra Kamthan** whose guidance, vision, and unwavering support played a significant role in the planning and execution of these renovation and development projects. His valuable inputs and continued encouragement have been instrumental in bringing these landmark projects to fruition.

GENERAL MAINTENANCE

The Club continued to accord the highest priority to the upkeep and maintenance of its infrastructure and recreational facilities. Routine maintenance and periodic refurbishment of the swimming pool, lawn tennis courts, squash courts, gymnasium, card rooms, landscaped lawns, gardens, common areas, electrical systems,

plumbing, and other member amenities were carried out throughout the year to ensure the highest standards of safety, cleanliness, functionality, and aesthetics. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND NOTES TO ACCOUNTS ANNEXED TO AND FORMING PART OF BALANCE SHEET AND STATEMENT OF PROFIT AND LOSS FOR THE YEAR ENDING 31ST MARCH, 2026

1. General

- a) The accounts are prepared on historical cost convention basis.
- b) Sales of goods and services, rental income, subscription & other fees, interest, other income, Purchases and expenditures are being recognized on accrual basis of accounting.
- c) Gratuity payment is accounted on cash basis.
- d) Accounting policies not specifically referred to are in consistent and in consonance with generally accepted accounting principles.

2. Property, Plant & Equipment

- a) Property, Plant & Equipment are accounted for at cost of acquisition inclusive of freight, cost of installation, ineligible ITC and incidental expenses related to acquisition of assets and reduced by the accumulated depreciation and realized value of assets disposed off.
- b) Major cost incurred for renovation of Rooms, Badminton Hall area & other Building of the club has been recognized as Fixed Assets looking to the long term uses and benefits of the same.
- c) Depreciation on fixed assets has been provided as per rates prescribed under The Income Tax Rules, 1961.
- d) Depreciation is provided for full year if asset is acquired and used for more than 182 days, half of the normal depreciation is provided for assets used for less than 182 days.

3. Inventories

Inventories are valued at Cost or Net Realizable Value whichever is lower using FIFO Method.

4. Balances in debtors & members accounts are subject to confirmation.



5. Previous year figures have been regrouped & rearranged wherever necessary to confirm to current years' classification & disclosure.
6. The Current Assets and Advances are approximately the value stated if realized in the ordinary course of business unless otherwise stated. Provisions for all ascertained liabilities have been made in the books of accounts at the amount reasonable necessary.
7. The provision for deferred tax for timing difference (as per ICAI Accounting Standard-22) on account of depreciation difference and carried forward losses of the club has not been made, if any, being the income of the club is exempt to tax under the concept of mutuality. Further, no provision required for current tax being deficit during the year and no deferred tax liability or assets has been ascertained for the same.

8. CONTINGENT LIABILITY

The club has been served various letters for payment of increased license fees of land to North Western Railway, Jaipur over the years. As per North Western Railway last letter dated 01/06/2026 they have demanded Rs. 7,02,17,462 on this account. Every time the management committees through Hony. Secretary has filed objection against the arbitrary increase in license fees without considering the special category granted to the club. On the contrary the club has demanded membership fees for the railway officer utilizing the club services 24X7 which is much higher than the license fees demanded by them time to time.

The club does not admit any increased license fees by North Western Railway and depositing the license fees as per terms of license granted. Hence no further provision has been made in the books of accounts. The management committee(s) has represented the matter in detail with railway authorities which are under consideration at their level.
